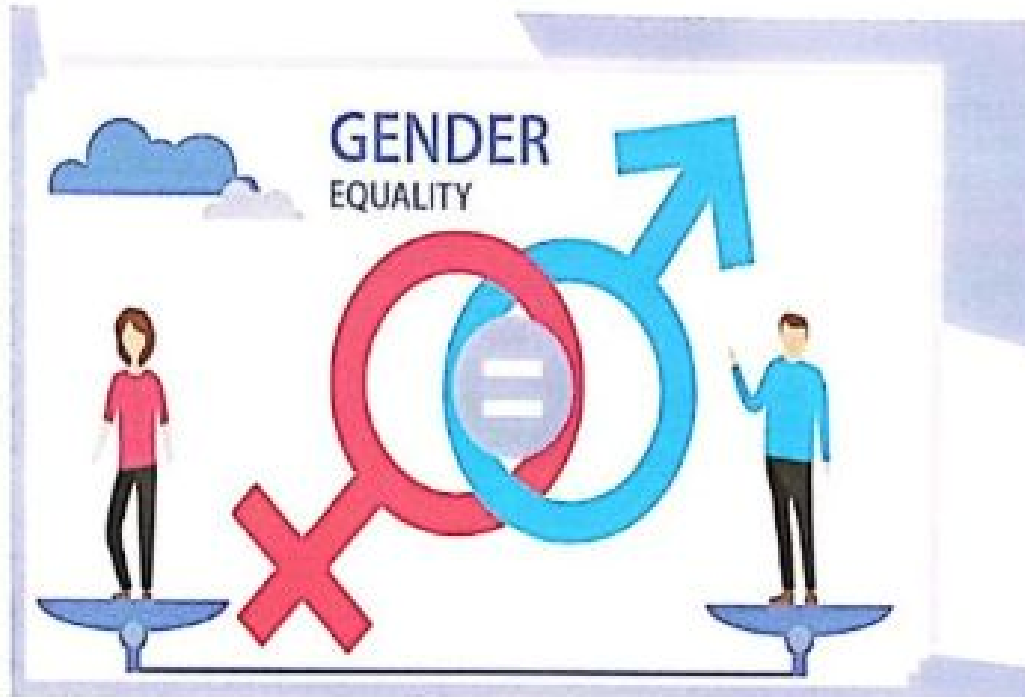

GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT (GAD) ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT



GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT (GAD) FOCAL POINT SYSTEM (GFPS) 2021 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Under Section 36 of Republic Act No. 9710, otherwise known as the Magna Carta of Women (MCW), all government departments, including their attached agencies, offices, bureaus, state universities, and colleges, government-owned and controlled corporations, local government units, and all other government instrumentalities shall adopt gender mainstreaming as a strategy to promote women's human rights and eliminate gender discrimination in their systems, structures, policies, programs, processes, and procedures.

To ensure that absolute, definite, genuine, and potential gender biases are removed, the government embarked on gender and development (GAD) as one of its priority programs. GAD focuses on the principle that development is for all.

Lemery Water District (LEWAD) considers and holds on that gender equality and women's empowerment are essential for meeting the water district's goals of comprehensive and continued development, as gender equality needs to be pursued in its own right for a just and equal society, and foster better development outcomes.

Concerning the 2021 Gender and Development (GAD) Plan and Budget submitted by Lemery Water District to the Local Water Utilities Administration, gender issues were determined as client-focused and organization-focused. Moreover, in light of the ongoing health situation and uncertainties brought about by this COVID-19 pandemic, some plans or activities were not accomplished.

The following programs aim to address the various gender needs and concerns of employees, officers, concessionaires of the district, and other individuals.

LEWAD GAD PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES

The following are the accomplished GAD Programs and Activities of the Lemery Water District in partnership with Primewater Infrastructure Corporation for Calendar Year 2021.

1. NRW MAINTENANCE AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Non-Revenue Water (NRW) is the volume of water supplied into the network that does not generate revenue.

Considering that NRW is a perennial problem of water districts, including LEWAD and it is also one of the reasons why LEWAD has entered into a Joint Venture



Agreement with Primewater Infrastructure Corporation. The LWDs allowable NRW is 20% set by LWUA. Thus, higher than this figure will require the utmost attention of the water districts and their partners.

This year, LEWAD and Primewater prioritize the program covering leak detection activity of main and service line pipe within the service area, meter management, pipe replacements, and network diagnostics, among others.

2. 2021 NATIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION

The Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) spearheads the Women's Month Celebration (NWMC) which is conducted annually in recognition of women's significant contributions to nation-building. This celebration is part of the worldwide observance of International Women's Day.

The following issuances serve as legal bases for the annual national activity:

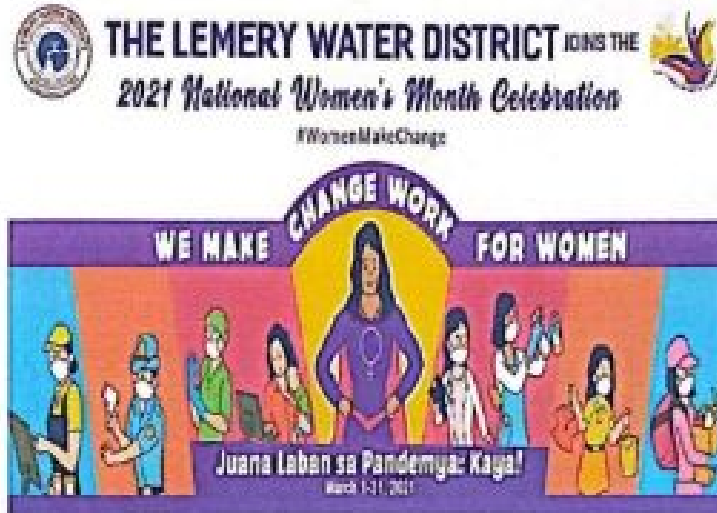
- Proclamation No. 224, s. of 1988 declaring the first week of March each year as Women's Week and March 8 as Women's Rights and International Peace Day;
- Proclamation No. 227, s. of 1088 providing for the observance of March as Women's Role in History Month; and
- Republic Act (RA) 6949 declaring March 8 of every year as National Women's Day.

The 2021 National Women's Month Celebration serves as a tribute, a platform, and a call to action that highlights the extraordinary roles of ordinary Juanas in society as trailblazers and harbingers of change. This celebration is also a venue to discuss and address the issues that women continue to face so empowerment can be fully achieved. The campaign is also a call for concrete, sustainable, and inclusive actions towards gender equality.

Government agencies including water districts are strongly encouraged to get the youth involved in their women's month activities.

The LEWAD-GAD under this year theme, "Juana Laban sa Pandemya, **KAYA!**" highlights the women's participation in battling the pandemic. As a form of appreciation, LEWAD distributed Forty (40) pieces of Personal Health Kit to the first 40 walk-in consumers on March 9, 2021, in



commemorating the women's month celebration. The adapted kit facemask, face shield, alcohol, and tissue.



3. WORLD WATER DAY 2021 CELEBRATION

Monday, 22nd of March 2021, in commemoration of the WORLD WATER DAY CELEBRATION, the Lemery Water District (LEWAD) as part of the global water community participated in the said event by the hanging of World Water Day Streamer to announce the occasion.

World Water Day which is celebrated on 22 March every year is about focusing attention on the importance of freshwater and advocating for the sustainable management of freshwater resources. The International theme for 2021 is **"Valuing Water"** and it seeks to focus awareness on the global water crisis.

This year, the UN chose the theme "Valuing Water," which remains consistent with SDG 6. The UN aims to raise global awareness about the real value of water. In one of their statements, the UN said, "the value of water is about much more than its price – water has enormous and complex value for our households, food, culture, health, education, economics and the integrity of our natural environment."

The celebration was also in compliance with the Local Water Utilities Administration (LWUA) Memorandum Circular 005-21 dated March 2, 20



4. TREE PLANTING ACTIVITY

The Lemery Water District employees in participation by Primewater Lemery trooped to the three (3) of its major pumping stations on October 2, 2021, to plant trees and continuously protect its groundwater. Said employees managed to plant 60 pcs Narra, 20 pcs kalamansi, 4 pcs guyabano, 2 pcs avocado, 1 pc mango, and 10 guava plants, totaling 97 trees. The worthwhile activity is also in line with the District's relentless efforts to protect and conserve the watershed.

The activity is almost a tradition of LEWAD every year and was considered successful in adding trees yearly to continually assure the provision of potable water to the District's water consumers.

The **Tree Planting Activity** aims to raise awareness to the society in the importance of planting and saving trees, express our concern for the environment, and diminish the unfavorable effects of climate change. To be aware of the importance of tree planting and its impact on the protections and increasing the growth and reproduction index of trees.

Employees were also instructed to strictly observe social distancing and strictly wear their facemask during planting time.

A. CSC, DOH and DOLE JMC No. 1, s. 2020

The Occupational Safety and Health Standards for the Public Sector is aimed at protecting all government employees from the dangers of injury, sickness, or death in the workplace through the adoption of safe and healthy working conditions to ensure the preservation of human lives and resources and prevent loss/damage of properties.

This shall also guide the government agencies in the development, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of Occupational Safety and Health for government employees.

Section V of the said JMC which is the Provision for Reasonable Working Conditions elaborated the following:

1. PROCUREMENT OF LEWAD PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

The following activities and precautionary measures should be implemented by agencies before the resumption of normal office operations:

- a. Disinfection or decontamination activities on all its buildings, facilities, and office vehicles. The disinfection should be part of the regular maintenance and upkeep of the agency;
- b. Conduct of health status survey to ensure that all those reporting to the office are in tip-top shape and that no one is exhibiting any of the symptoms of COVID-19 disease; and
- c. Modification of the workplace layout to ensure observance of physical distancing requirements of those who will be reporting to the office.



Agencies shall implement minimum health standards protocol at all times such as wearing of face masks, face shields, taking of body temperature, and presence of sanitation stations and other appropriate PPE.

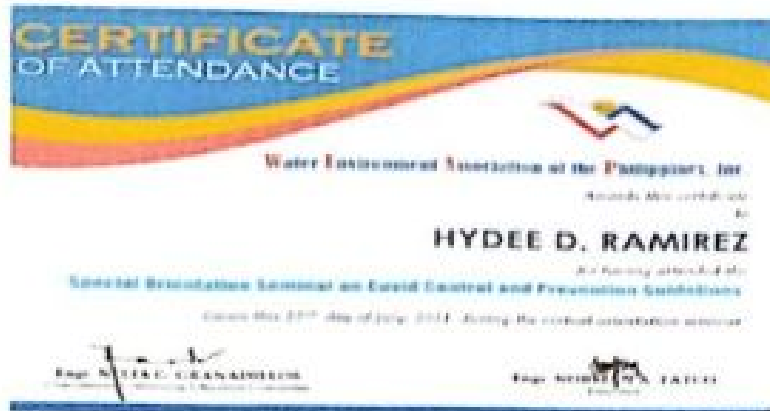

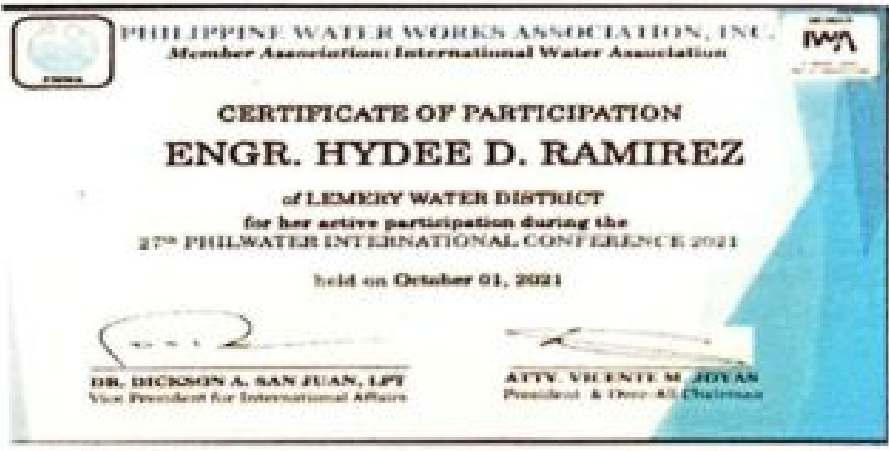

This is part of rewarding LEWAD and Primewater Lemery staff and recognizing their hard work and dedicated service to the agency.



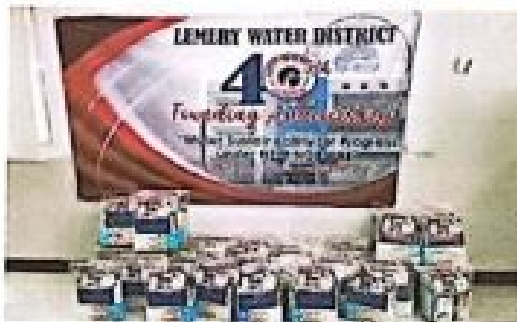
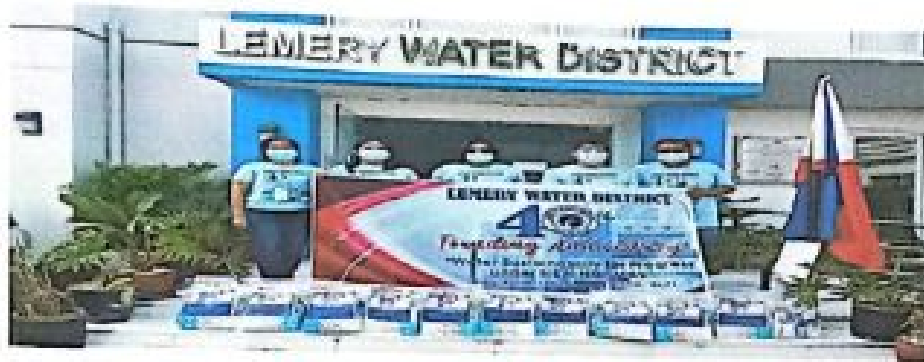
6. OTHER GAD RELATED ACTIVITIES

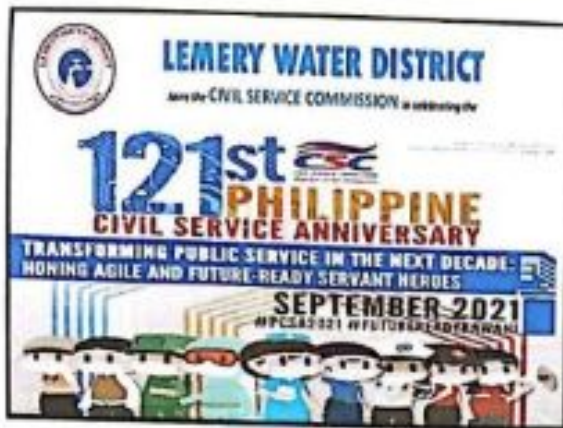

c. LEWAD/PRIMEWATER LEMERY AND RCDL COASTAL CLEAN-UP

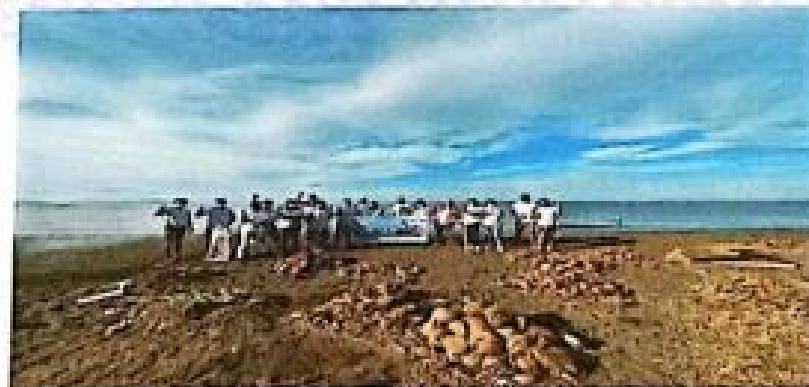

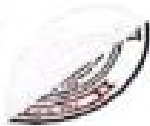

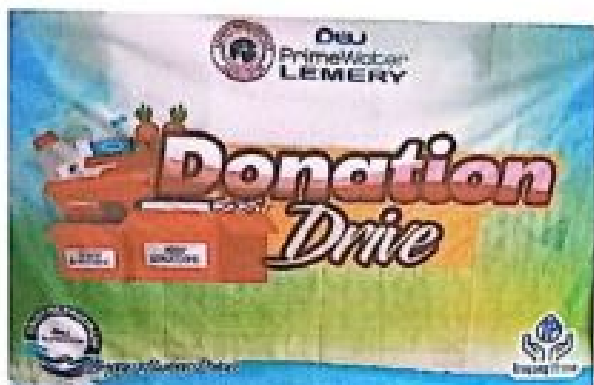
e. LEWAD-PRIMEWATER 'S DONATION DRIVE

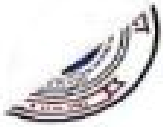
